



# By definition:

# in·ti·ma·cy noun \'in-tə-mə-sē\

1a: intrinsic, essential

b: belonging to or characterizing one's deepest nature

2: marked by very close association, contact, or familiarity

3a: marked by a warm friendship developing through long association

b: suggesting informal warmth or privacy

4: of a very personal or private nature



#### By definition: worship

Hebrew/Greek text records two base word which translate "worship" in modern texts.

Shachah - to bow down

(Qal) to bow down

(Hiphil) to depress (fig)

(Hithpael) to bow down, prostrate oneself

before superior in homage

before God in worship

before false gods

before angels



## **Definition: worship**

Proskuneo -to kiss the hand to (towards) one, in token of reverence

- among the Orientals, esp. the Persians, to fall upon the knees and touch the ground with the forehead as an expression of profound reverence
- in the NT by kneeling or prostration to do homage (to one) or make obeisance, whether in order to express respect or to make supplication
  - used of homage shown to men and beings of superior rank
    - to the Jewish high priests, God, Christ, heavenly beings and/or demons

- Family by family units Deuteronomy , Joshua 24:15, Job 1:5 , Luke 8:39, Luke 10:39, John 1:41, John 4:53, Acts 16:15, Acts 16:33
- <u>In private homes</u> Relatives & Non-relatives 1 Timothy 5:4 Acts 1:1,3,14; 5:42; 12:12; 20:7-9; Romans 16:5; 1 Corinthians 16:19; Colossians 4:15; Philemon 1:2
- Public and communities On Mount Gerizim and Mount Ebal Joshua 8:32-35 Public, in the temple Jeremiah 26:2; Luke 18:10; 24:53 Deuteronomy 16:11; 31:11-13

- But as for me, I will come into thy house in the multitude of thy mercy: and in thy fear will I worship toward thy holy temple. (Psalm 5:7)
- All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee. (Psalm 22:27)
- All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him: and none can keep alive his own soul. (Psalm 22:29)
- Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness. (Psalm 29:20
- So shall the king greatly desire thy beauty: for he is thy Lord; and worship thou him. (Psalm 45:11)

But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. (1 Samuel 16:14)

And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubleth thee. (1 Samuel 16:15)

Let our lord now command thy servants, which are before thee, to seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well. (1 Samuel 16:16)

And Saul said unto his servants, Provide me now a man that can play well, and bring him to me. (1 Samuel 16:17)



Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD is with him. (1 Samuel 16:18)

Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which is with the sheep. (1 Samuel 16:19)

And Jesse took an ass laden with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent them by David his son unto Saul. (1 Samuel 16:20)



And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer. (1 Samuel 16:21)

And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight. (1 Samuel 16:22)

And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him. (1 Samuel 16:23)



#### **Spiritual Warfare**

#### **Key Strategy – Tactical assault and annihilation of the male**

- 1 Kings 14:10 (Lord vs Jeroboam) Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.
- 1 Kings 16:11 (Lord/Jehu the son of Hanani vs Baasha) And it came to pass, when he began to reign, as soon as he sat on his throne, that he slew all the house of Baasha: he left him not one that pisseth against a wall, neither of his kinsfolks, nor of his friends.
- 1 Kings 21:21 (Elijah the Tishbite vs Ahab/Jezebel) Behold, I will bring evil upon thee, and will take away thy posterity, and will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel,



#### **Spiritual Warfare**

**Key Strategy – Tactical assault and annihilation of the male** 

2 Kings 9:8 – (Elisha - Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi vs Ahab/Jezebel) For the whole house of Ahab shall perish: and I will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel:

1 Samuel 25:23 - (David/Men vs. Nathan/Abigail). So and more also do God unto the enemies of David, if I leave of all that pertain to him by the morning light any that pisseth against the wall.

1 Samuel 25:34 - For in very deed, as the Lord God of Israel liveth, which hath kept me back from hurting thee, except thou hadst hasted and come to meet me, surely there had not been left unto Nabal by the morning light any that pisseth against the wall

Pisseth shâthan -

**Brown-Driver-Briggs' Definition** 

1.(Hiphil) to urinate

1.one who urinates (used as a designation of a male)

**Strong's Definition** 

Source: a primitive root;

Meaning: (causatively) to make water, i.e. urinate

Usage: piss.



#### **Spiritual Warfare**

Matthew 16:18 - And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Ephesians 6:11 - Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. KJV

- **2 Corinthians 10:3 -** For though we walk in the flesh [as mortal men], we are not carrying on our [spiritual] warfare according to the flesh and using the weapons of man.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 The weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood]. Our weapons are divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. AMP

#### BATTLEFIELDS



Romans 12:1 - Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies dedicating all of yourselves, set apart as a living sacrifice, holy and well-pleasing to God, which is your rational (logical, intelligent) act of worship.

World - kósmos -

## Thayer's human family

1. the ungodly multitude; the whole mass of men alienated from God, and therefore hostile to the cause of Christ- the inhabitants of the earth, men, the 2 any aggregate or general collection of particulars of any sort a the Gentiles as contrasted to the Jews (Rom. 11:12 etc)

**Strong's** - Probably from the base of <u>G2865</u>; orderly *arrangement*, that is, *decoration*; by implication the *world* (in a wide or narrow sense, **including its inhabitants**, **literally or figuratively [morally])**: - adorning, world.

**Mounce's** - world: earth, world system, whole universe; adornment. In some contexts, the world is simply the place where people live, in other contexts (especially in John), the world is a system opposed to God

Thayer's - Born again - - ánothen

- 1. from above, from a higher place
- 2.of things which come from heaven or God
- 3.from the first, from the beginning, from the very first
- 4. anew, over again

**Strong's -** From <u>G507</u>; *from above*; by analogy *from the first*; by implication *anew:* - **from above**, **again**, **from the beginning (very first)**, **the top.** 

Mounce's - from above; from the beginning; again, anew

**Key Strategy – Blind men to need for Salvation through Jesus Christ** 

John 3:3 Jesus responded and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless someone is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Kingdom - basileia -

#### **Thayer's**

- 1. royal power, kingship, dominion, rule
- 1.<u>not to be confused with an actual kingdom</u> but rather the right or authority to rule over a kingdom
- 2.of the royal power of Jesus as the triumphant Messiah
- 3.of the royal power and dignity conferred on Christians in the Messiah's kingdom
- 1.a kingdom, the territory subject to the rule of a king
- 2.used in the N.T. to refer to the reign of the Messiah

<u>Strong's</u> - From <u>G935</u>; properly *royalty*, that is, (abstractly) *rule*, or (concretely) a *realm* (literally or figuratively): - kingdom, + reign.

**Mounce's** - kingdom, kingship, royal rule

Thayer's - born again - gennáō -

#### of men who fathered children

- 1. to be born
- 2. to be begotten
  - a. of women giving birth to children

#### 1 metaph.

- a. to engender, cause to arise, excite
- b. in a Jewish sense, of one who brings others over to his way of life, to convert someone
- c. of God making Christ his son
- d. of God making men his sons through faith in Christ's work

**Strong's -** From a variation of <u>G1085</u>; **to** *procreate* (properly of the father, but by extension of the mother); figuratively to *regenerate:* **- bear, beget, be born, bring forth, conceive**, be delivered of, gender, make, spring.

Mounce's - to become the father of; to bear, give birth to; (pass.) to be conceived, born

# BATTLEFIELDS - MANHOOD/MASCULINITY



**Spiritual Warfare** 

## **Key Strategy – Blind believers to distinction: feminization of masculinity**

1 Corinthians 6:9 - Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

# Thayer's - Effeminate - malakós - soft, soft to the touch

- 1. metaph. in a bad sense
- 2. Effeminate
- 3. of a catamite a boy kept for homosexual relations with a man
- 4. of a male who submits his body to unnatural lewdness
- 5. of a male prostitute

#### Effeminate - malakós

Strong's- Of uncertain affinity; soft, that is, fine (clothing); figuratively a catamite: - effeminate, soft

Mounce's - fine, soft; (n.) male prostitute, a male homosexual who is the passive sex partner

# BATTLEFIELDS - MANHOOD/MASCULINITY



**Spiritual Warfare** 

**Key Strategy – Blind believers to distinction: feminization of masculinity** 

1 Corinthians 6:9 - Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

**Abusers of themselves with mankind** - Arsenokoítēs

**Thayer's -** one who lies with a male as with a female, sodomite, homosexual

**Strong's -** From <u>G730</u> and <u>G2845</u>; a *sodomite:* - abuser of (that defile) self with mankind.

**Mounce's -** one engaging in homosexual acts (likely referring to the active male partner), sexual deviant

## BATTTLEFIELDS- EUROPEANIZATION OF FAITH



#### **Spiritual Warfare**

Key Strategy – Europeanization of the Way (Faith) – Christianity is the white man's religion give to you black folk in slavery.

Acts 11:26 - And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch. (Only mention 3xs bible)

**Thayer's** Christian – Christian, Christian, a follower of Christ

## Ethiopian Eunuch -

**Acts 8:27 -** And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

Acts 8:34 - And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man?

**Acts 8:36 -** And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?

Acts 8:38-39 - And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. [39] And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

## BATTLEFIELDS - BLACK MALE IDENTITY



### **Spiritual Warfare**

Key Strategy – Issue of Black Male Identity; The black man is the original Jew. (Hebrew-Israelite Movement)

1 Timothy 1:4 - Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

**Titus 3:9 - But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies**, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain

## **GOAL** –Regain the loss of Adam

## **Genesis 5:1-5.** (Reproduction of fallen <u>Humanity</u>)

This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created (8800) man, in the likeness of God made (8804) he him; 3 And Adam lived (8799) an hundred and thirty years, and begat (8686) a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called (8799) his name Seth: 4 And the days of Adam after he had begotten (8687) Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat (8686) sons and daughters: 5 And all the days that Adam lived (8804) were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died (8799).

## BATTLEFIELDS — PULPIT IMPOSTERS



#### **Spiritual Warfare**

**Key Strategy – Five Imposters - The Perversion/Bastardization of the pulpit.** 

**John 10:11** - I am the good shepherd: the **good shepherd** giveth his life for the sheep.

**John 10:14 -** I am the **good shepherd**, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

**John 10:5 -** And a <u>stranger</u> will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.


**John 10:8 -** All that ever came before me are <u>thieves and robbers</u>: but the sheep did not hear them.

**John 10:12-13 -** But he that is <u>an hireling</u>, and not the sheepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the **wolf coming**, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and <u>the wolf</u> catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep. [13] The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep.

- 1. <u>Classical</u>: PROVE GOD & DEFEND CLAIM –cosmological or teleological arguments.
